### EMORY SHUTTLES

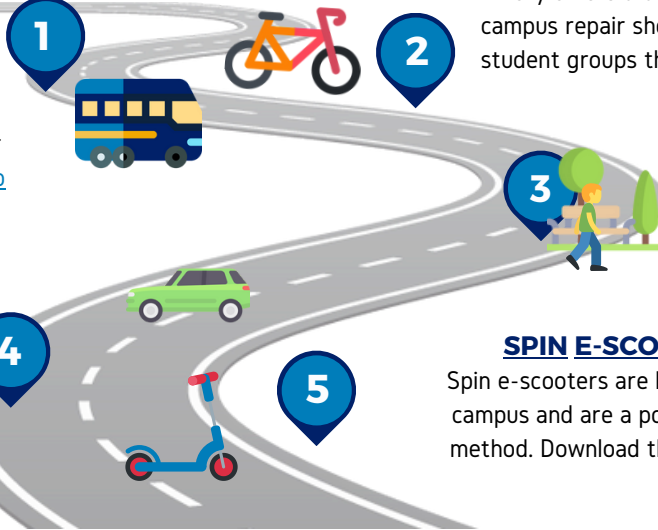
### ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS

The stations are located at Clairmont Tower, in Peavine II parking deck and on Oxford Rd.

Passes are available for graduate students who walk or bike to Emory.



### BIKE EMORY

Emory offers a bike rental program, on-campus repair shop, fix-it stations, and student groups that [foster bike culture.](#)

With the **Break Free from Plastic Pledge**, Emory will plan to reduce single use plastics on the Atlanta & Oxford campuses

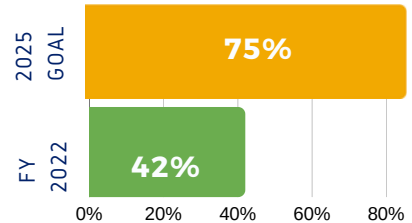
## FOOD & DINING

By 2025, Emory University aims to purchase 75% of its food from local and/or sustainable sources.



### MAKE SURE TO VISIT

#### 1 EMORY FARMERS MARKET

The Emory Farmers Market runs on Tuesdays from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm on McDonough Plaza. The Emory Farmers Market allows Emory to support the local small businesses and enjoy delicious, local food.

#### 2 EMORY DINING LOCATIONS

Emory Dining serves the most local & sustainable food on campus.

#### 3 EMORY OXFORD COLLEGE ORGANIC FARM

The certified organic farm offers a program in which subscribers receive a weekly box filled with fresh, local produce. Sign up today and visit the farm on Emory's Oxford campus.

#### 4 EMORY'S EIGHT EDUCATIONAL GARDENS

The gardens provide free produce and hands-on experience growing your own food. Email [gardens@emory.edu](mailto:gardens@emory.edu) to learn about volunteer work days and what's in season.

#### 5 EAGLE FOOD CO-OP

Campus Life supports a free food co-op at Bread Coffeehouse. Students can request food, including produce from the Educational Gardens.

# WASTE

## WHERE SHOULD MY WASTE GO?



### BLUE RECYCLE BINS

ALL INORGANIC material (e.g. chip bags, snack wrappers, plastic utensils, plastic film, plastic & metal containers, to-go food containers, and all other single-use plastic items).

### BLACK LANDFILL BINS

Only food grade styrofoam, disposable masks, sanitary wipes, disposable gloves, used baby diapers, cat litter and dog waste.

### GREEN COMPOST BINS

ALL ORGANIC material (e.g. food, used napkins & tissues, and labelled "compostables" such as GREEN utensils & paper to-go containers from Emory Dining Locations.



### LANDFILL

### KEEP WIPES OUT OF PIPES!

*Sanitary wipes should never be flushed, as they clog sewer pipes.*

DIPOSABLE MASKS, WIPES, AND GLOVES MUST BE PLACED IN THE LANDFILL BINS TO PROTECT EMORY'S STAFF AND VENDORS.



### COMPOST

**SEPARATE YOUR WASTE - DON'T SORT IN HASTE**  
*Plastic containers and bags with food in them cannot be composted.*

## HARD-TO-RECYCLE MATERIALS

Emory provides a collection area for materials that are **harder to recycle** and cannot be placed in the blue recycle bins. These bins are located in most major buildings on campus.
